**Subject: Butler Avenue Culvert Project (Butler Avenue Bridge Replacement)**

Dear New Britain Township Resident or Business Owner,

At its Regular Board of Supervisors Meeting on Monday, June 18, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., representatives from PennDOT will be in attendance at the Township's request, to provide Township residents with information on the PennDOT Butler Avenue Culvert Project. Those interested and affected by the proposed project and the potential closure of W. Butler Avenue are encouraged to attend.

PennDOT will be making a presentation, approximately 15 minutes in length, on how PennDOT proposes to replace the Culvert Bridge along W. Butler Avenue that spans the West Branch of the Neshaminy Creek around St. Jude School near Brittany Drive. They will also discuss the proposed detour route. PennDOT representatives will also be available to answer questions and concerns from the public.

We encourage residents to come to the meeting to obtain information and ask questions. Please let your neighbors know, as we may not have reached all Township residents or businesses by mail.
