**ORDINANCE #2015-08-05
(Duly Adopted August ____, 2015)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF NEW BRITAIN TOWNSHIP TO SET THE SPEED LIMIT ON
BARRY ROAD AT 40 MILES AN HOUR.**

WHEREAS, New Britain Township (“Township”) has the authority pursuant to Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. §66506 & Article XXIII) and the Motor Vehicle Code (75 Pa.C.S.A. §3362 and §6109) to regulate the speed of motor vehicles or other vehicles on Township roads and to impose penalties for violations of the regulations adopted; and

WHEREAS, under the applicable provisions of the Vehicle Code, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (“PennDOT”) has established the speed limit on Barry Road, a state road, at 40 miles an hour; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that it is in the best interests of the Township to adopt a Township Ordinance mirroring PennDOT’s speed limit of 40 miles an hour on Barry Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of New Britain Township, as follows:

SECTION I Speed Limit.

The Chart under §15-201.1 of the New Britain Township Code is hereby amended as follows:

STREET	BETWEEN	MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT
Barry Road (SR1006)	Railroad Avenue & New Galena Road	40 mph

SECTION II Posting.

The proper authorities of the Township are authorized to erect official signs establishing the traffic regulations as set forth in this Ordinance, in conformity with the provisions of the Vehicle Code.

SECTION III Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV Severability.


If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of New Britain Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION V Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after final enactment.






