

New Britain Township Park & Recreation Meeting

1. Approval of Minutes – A motion was made by Marco Tustanowsky, seconded by Carl Haag, and unanimously carried to approve the minutes from June 21, 2011.
2. 4<sup>th</sup> Of July
  - a. Angela Benner, informed the board that the 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade ran very smoothly, and the only complaint that was issued was in reference to a gentlemen riding a six wheeler in the parade he was doing wheelies, and riding on residents lawns. Leslie complimented Angela Benner on a job well done.

Angela stated that this is moving forward within a week or two. Angela explained the West Branch Park map, which was on display during the meeting. The engineers have already staked the property said, Wayne Fultz. Completion of the project will be done in 2 ½ years said, Wayne.
  - b. Santa House – Angela announced the days for the Santa House December 3<sup>rd</sup> and the 10<sup>th</sup>. Angela Benner informed the board that Angela Pomeisl will be taking this project over. Angela Benner said, she would be there to help Angela Pomeisl.
  - c. Fall Festival- September 24<sup>th</sup>. 11am to 4pm. Angela Benner asked the Park and Recreation Board if they would like to have a stand during the fall festival. Angela Benner said, if you have any ideas to contact Angela Pomeisl.
  - d. Angela Benner, did inform the Board that this would be her last Park and Recreation Meeting, and that Angela Pomeisl would be taking over for her. Everyone told Angela Benner, what a wonderful job she has done with everything and that they will miss her.
5. Adjournment- A motion was made Robert Ralston, seconded by Charles Maeyer, and unanimously carried to end the meeting at 7:30p.m.
