## MEETING MINUTES

June 17, 2014

A Meeting of the New Britain Township Parks and Recreation Advisory Board was held on June 17, 2014 at the Township Administration Building, 207 Park Avenue, New Britain Township, Pa., beginning at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were: Marco Tustanowsky, Charles Maeyer, Regina Armitage, Bob Ralston, Dan Mackintosh, William Jones, James Bender and Samuel Garcia. Also, in attendance were Wayne Fultz, Scott Ambron and Jo Ann Lapp, New Britain Township Staff.

**1. Approval of Minutes of May 22, 2014:** Upon motion by Mr. Mackintosh, seconded by Mr. Ralston, the May 22, 2014 minutes were approved as written. Mr. Jones abstained.

**2. Movie Night in the Park:** Mr. Fultz reserved two lights from George's Tool Rental. Mr. Bender told the Board that if a letter is written to North Wales Water requesting to borrow lights, the request will be granted. Mrs. Lapp will write the letter.

Mr. Bender gave the \$500 check from North Wales Water to Mrs. Lapp as sponsor of movie night. Mr. Fultz, Mr. Bender, Ms. Armitage, Mr. Ralston, Mr. & Mrs. Jones and Mrs. Lapp all plan on attending. **4. Other Business:** Mr. Tustanowsky asked that the July meeting of the Park & Recreation Board be held to discuss the Board becoming involved with the Veteran's Committee and the Fall Festival. Everyone agreed.
