MEETING MINUTES June 18, 2013

A Meeting of the New Britain Township Parks and Recreation Advisory Board was held on June 18, 2013, at the Township Administration Building, 207 Park Avenue, New Britain Township, Pa., beginning at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were: Dan Mackintosh, Charles Maeyer, William Jones and Nancy Jones. Also, in attendance were Jo Ann Lapp and Wayne Fultz, New Britain Township Parks and Recreation Department.

1. Approval of Minutes of May 22, 2013: Upon motion by Mr. Mackintosh, seconded by Mr. Maeyer, the May 22, 2013 minutes were approved as written.

2. Jon Hickland, Eagle Scout Project: Tom Fountain, Lenape Valley Baseball was present to introduce Jon Hickland to the Board. Jon Hickland is an Eagle Scout Candidate who is proposing a project for North Branch Park. Mr. Fountain believes that the project will benefit Lenape Valley Baseball as well as North Branch Park. Mr. Hickland is proposing 4 warm-up pitching mounds, 2 each for fields #5 & #6 and repainting the dugouts. His proposal has been approved by the Buck County Boy Scout Council.

MOTION: A motion was made by Mr. Jones to recommend Jon Hickland move ahead with his proposed project. Mr. Mackintosh seconded the nomination and it was unanimously approved.


