

**New Britain Township Park & Recreation Meeting
March 20, 2012**

A Regular Meeting of the New Britain Township Park and Recreation Advisory Board was held at the New Britain Township Building, 207 Park Avenue, Chalfont, PA on March 20 2012 beginning at 7:05 p.m. In attendance were: Bob Ralston, Marco Tustanowsky, Regina Armitage, Nancy Jones, Scott Ambron, Angela Pomeisl and Austin Ralston.

1. **Approval of Minutes** – A motion was made by Dan Mackintosh seconded by Marco Tustanowsky and unanimously carried to approve the Minutes from February 21, 2012.

2. **Easter Egg Hunt** –

2.1. Philadelphia Sports Club (Lisa Marsland, General Manager) would like to donate eggs to the Township Easter Egg Hunt. Angela Pomeisl put in front of the board an email that she received from the Philadelphia Sports Club who would like to generously donate Easter Eggs to the Township Easter Egg Hunt they would like to offer pre stuffed eggs to add to our hunt. 20 eggs for each age group with one free swim lesson. And one golden egg for each age group with a free 8 week session. The total would be 100 free swim lessons (value \$2000) and then five golden eggs (8 week swim lessons= value \$800) total donation value= \$2800.00. A motion was made by Dan Mackintosh and seconded by Regina Armitage and unanimously carried to approve the donation of eggs from the Philadelphia Sports Club.

3. **Other Business** –

3.1. Movie Night - Angela Pomeisl gave each board member a copy of an email from Rick Eisenhacker, reference to cost. His cost is \$450.00 for the 19.5 diagonal (16' across) frame screen, he always suggest to start smaller to see if the event works out, and the turnout is successful and then kick it up a notch the following year. Price includes all sound, projection, screen and cabling as well as set up and operation. The only thing we would be responsible for would be the DVD. Generally the 19.5' works for up to 350 people. Angela also informed the board that we would have to register with SWANK.com for rights to show the movie, the cost of this is \$200 to \$400 per movie. The board seemed very excited about wanting to offer a movie night in the township. Dan Mackintosh asked what is our budget for doing a movie night? Scott Ambron replied that it would be a Park and Recreation Event. Angela replied that she will look into it. Marco Tustanowsky said that Buxmont Party rental place would donate their hot dog machines again as they did for the Fall Festival and also see if Hatfield Meats would donate hot dogs, and Scott said that Acme donating rolls for the hot dogs maybe they would donate again. Marco suggested that we could do a fairly new movie that is geared to all age groups, Nancy Jones said that she really enjoyed but she couldn't think of the name of the movie, so Scott helped her out. The movie was called, Dolphin tails. Nancy said I really, really liked that movie. and Regina Armitage got a laugh out of it and said, Nancy really likes that movie and everyone giggled. Bob Ralston asked Angela to look into how much a screen would cost if we purchased our own.

Adjournment: Being no further business, a motion was made by Dan Mackintosh, seconded by Marco Tustanowsky and unanimously carried, to end the Meeting at 7:50 p.m.
