

**New Britain Township Park & Recreation Meeting
February 21, 2012**

A Regular Meeting of the New Britain Township Park and Recreation Advisory Board was held at the New Britain Township Building, 207 Park Avenue, Chalfont, PA on February 21, 2012, 2012 beginning at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were: Bob Ralston, Marco Tustanowsky, Dan Mackintosh, Leslie Bilotta, Wayne Fultz, Charles Maeyer, William Jones, Nancy Jones, Scott Ambron, Angela Pomeisl and Austin Ralston.

1. Re – Org – A motion was made by Dan Mackintosh, seconded by William Jones, and unanimously carried to elect Bob Ralston as Chairman. A motion was made by Dan Mackintosh, seconded by William Jones, and unanimously carried to elect Marco Tustanowsky as Vice Chairman.
2. **Approval of Minutes** – A motion was made by Bob Ralston, seconded by Dan Mackintosh and unanimously carried to approve the Minutes from January 17, 2012.
3. **Easter Egg Hunt** –Saturday March 24th a rain date of March 31st. Starts at 10:00am sharp. Angela Pomeisl asked for volunteers Marco Tustanowsky, Leslie Bilotta and Bob Ralston, said they would volunteer their time. Bob also will bring his PA System. Leslie asked if we could donate the used plastic eggs again. We will be donating half to Christ Home and half to Plumstead Township the same as last year.
4. **West Branch Park** – Wayne Fultz spoke of the progress of the West Branch Park Renovations. Wayne let the board know that 95% of the fill was donated by Cutler a developer from Hilltown Township along with time and manpower to haul the fill to West Branch Park. We do need an additional 3500 to 4000 cubic yards of fill to finish the rough grade. He also informed them that the bid specs will be finalized by the end of April. He did also informed them that Angela Benner had applied for a grant with the BCCD (Bucks County Conservation District) and Aqua that provides money for trees and shrubs. Leslie Bilotta asked if the fields will be lit? Wayne answered yes. Leslie also wanted to know if the fields were lit before? Wayne replied No. Leslie wanted to know if the neighbors of WBP were aware that the fields were now going to be lit? And will there be a sound system? And do we have to pay the builders? Wayne replied that there will only be 4 lights on the field, and there will be no sound system and the builder donating their time. Marco Tustanowsky asked if the playground at WBP will be elevated? Wayne replied yes. Bob Ralston wanted to know if there was anything that was salvageable from the playground? And Wayne told them no everything is outdated. Bill Jones asked, What about the Ball fields? Wayne informed him that the ball fields will be done at a later date. Dan Macinktosh asked where are the lights going to be placed? There will only be four lights concentrating on the ball fields. Nancy Jones asked Will the lights be on at certain times? Wayne replied, yes.
5. **Other Business** –
 - 5.1. **Leslie Bilotta**
Leslie Bilotta spoke to the board about cyber bullying. Leslie informed them that the New Britain Business Alliance will be hosting a meeting here at the Township Administration Building on Tuesday April 3, 2012 at 9:00am with Detective Cummings, CB Cares and the Peace Valley Executive Director to explain cyber bullying and what is going on. Detective Cummings will also discuss child predators.

Adjournment: Being no further business, a motion was made by Dan Mackintosh, seconded by Charles Maeyer and unanimously carried, to end the Meeting at 7:30 p.m.
