MEETING MINUTES May 22, 2014

A Meeting of the New Britain Township Parks and Recreation Advisory Board was held on May 22, 2014 at the Township Administration Building, 207 Park Avenue, New Britain Township, Pa., beginning at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were: Marco Tustanowsky, Charles Maeyer, Regina Armitage, Bob Ralston, Dan Mackintosh, Cameron Ralston and Kyra Tustanowsky. Also, in attendance were Scott Ambron and Jo Ann Lapp, New Britain Township Staff.

1. Approval of Minutes of April 15, 2014: Upon motion by Mr. Mackintosh, seconded by Mr. Ralston, the April 15, 2014 minutes were approved as written.

2. Movie Night in the Park: After discussion, the Board members decided the movie they will be showing is Rio 2. Mrs. Lapp will order the movie. They agreed that field #1 would be the best field to use for movie night. Mrs. Lapp will distribute flyers to the local day care centers and posters to the elementary schools. Staff will make A frame signs for the entrance to the Township Office. Mr. Ralston has lights that can be used to get the attendees safely to their cars after the movie. Staff will talk to Chief Scafidi about traffic control. The Board has no interest in selling snacks and drinks, Mrs. Lapp will contact Abundance Water Ice to see if they would like to sell in the park that night.

3. July 4th Parade: Mrs. Lapp told the Board that all three bands have accepted the invitation to participate in the parade.

After discussion, Mr. Mackintosh made the motion to recommend Joe Greene as Parade Marshal, seconded by Mr. Ralston and unanimously approved.

The decision on the Jr. Parade Marshal has been postponed until the end of May to give the schools more time to give their recommendations.

Mrs. Lapp asked everyone to ask people that they know with convertibles if they would like to participate in the parade.

4. Other Business: Mr. Mackintosh showed a picture of a wheelchair swing that he had mentioned at the last meeting. Staff will research pricing. Mr. Mackintosh asked if staff would check with the local elementary schools to see if there are any children in wheelchairs to make sure there is need for the swing in the Township.

Mr. Tustanowsky thanked everyone for allowing the kids to sell drinks & snacks in the park. He told the Board that they raised a lot of money for cancer research.

Mr. Tustanowsky told the Board that the Veterans Committee does not have the time to organize the blood drive. If anyone is interested to take the project over you can contact the Township Office.


