


New Britain Township Park & Recreation Meeting
July 27, 2010

An official meeting of the New Britain Township Park and Recreation Advisory Board was held at the New Britain Township Building on July 27, 2010 beginning at 7:07 p.m. In attendance were: Robert Ralston, Dan Mackintosh, Marco Tustanowsky, Carl Haag, Scott Ambron and Angela Benner.

1. Approval of Minutes – A motion was made by Dan Mackintosh, seconded by Carl Haag, and unanimously carried to approve the minutes from June 29, 2010.
2. 4th of July – The Park & Recreation Board agreed that everything seemed to go very smooth at the parade. Dan asked if we can look into allowing spectators to get through the barricade that is set up at Bristol Road and Upper State Road. Bob suggested making sure that the horses are not near any music next year in the parade.
3. Veterans Park – Angela updated everyone on the different fundraisers that the veterans committee is planning to have as follows:
 - a. Fall festival – Sept. 25
 - i. Angela asked if the Park & Recreation Board would like to hold something in conjunction with the Fall Festival. The board thinks it would be a good idea and will starting coming up with some ideas and contact Angela with them.
 - b. Veterans Benefit ball – Nov. 13
 - c. Silent Auction to culminate at the veterans ball
4. Township Park – Angela distributed a description of all Township parks and went over briefly with the Park & Recreation Board so that everyone knew where all the parks were located in the Township.
5. Other Business – Angela distributed a memo from the New Britain Township Planning Commission requesting that the Park & Recreation Board work on updating their portion of the comp. plan. Angela asked everyone to review it and at the next meeting let her know what changes they would like to see made.
6. The next regular meeting of the Park and Recreation was scheduled for September 28, 2010 at 7:00p.m. Being no further business; a motion was made Dan Mackintosh, seconded by Marco Tustanowsky and unanimously carried to end the meeting at 7:41p.m.
