## **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-05**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NEW BRITAIN, BUCKS **PENNSYLVANIA** AUTHORIZING THE **TOWNSHIP** COUNTY, MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET-ASIDE PROGRAM REIMBURSEMENT GRANT AGREEMENT AND RELATED DOCUMENTS CONCERNING THE TOWNSHIP'S PARTICIPATION IN THE NESHAMINY **GREENWAY** TRAIL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

**WHEREAS**, New Britain Township is working with Chalfont Borough, New Britain Borough, and Doylestown Township on a multi-municipal construction project, known as the Neshaminy Greenway Trail, to develop pedestrian/bicycle trails throughout and interconnecting all four of these municipalities ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation ("PennDOT") has awarded a grant to these municipalities for the Neshaminy Greenway Project ("Grant"); and

**WHEREAS**, New Britain Township is the lead municipality for the PennDOT Grant, and as such, is responsible for executing various documents concerning this Grant.

**NOW THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED** by New Britain Township Board of Supervisors that the New Britain Township Manager, Eileen M. Bradley, or her designee, Assistant to the Manager Michael Walsh, is hereby authorized to sign the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program Reimbursement Grant Agreement required by PennDOT, with signatory permission retroactive to September 10, 2018, in conjunction with the Grant, as well as any other documents necessary for the Grant to be awarded and used in furtherance of the Project.
