Alternative #1 will be accepted or rejected at the Township's discretion. Proposals must be upon the forms furnished by New Britain Township. Contract "A" will require prevailing wage rates. New Britain Township reserves the right to accept or reject any and all proposals or to award alternatives individually to the lowest qualified bidder.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. General

- a. The proposal must be typewritten or printed.
- b. New Britain Township reserves the right to increase, decrease, add or eliminate the items/street locations and/or quantities on the bid proposal in order to maintain the contract price within available funding.
- c. If more than one proposal on any project is submitted by any individual, firm or partnership, corporation or association under the same or different names, only one lowest proposal will be considered.
- d. New Britain Township reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids and/or to award alternatives individually to the lowest qualified bidder.

2. Qualifications of Bidders

The owner will make such investigations as it deems necessary to determine the ability and competency of the Bidder to perform the work in the manner and within the time limit stipulated, and the Bidder shall furnish to the Owner all such information and data for this purpose as the Owner may request, such as evidence to the resources to fulfill the conditions of the Contract and Specifications. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bids received if the investigation fails to satisfy the Owner that such a bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract and to complete the work as specified.

In addition to the financial qualifications, the Bidder may be required to prove to the satisfaction of the Owner that he has within the two year period prior to the submission of this bid, successfully completed a contract for similar work in an amount of not less than seventy-five per cent (75%) of the amount of the proposed Contract.

In determining bidder responsibility for this work, attention will be given to the method of maintenance which the bidder plans to follow, the available experienced and skilled men which he plans to use in the prosecution of the work; and the type of equipment and material he plans to utilize.

Bidders shall be PennDot pre-qualified at the time of the bid opening and submit a copy of Certification and what certification is for.

3. Contents of Proposal Forms and Submission

The Form of Proposal shall remain intact, with all papers bound with or attached, and shall all be submitted before the date and time specified. Proposals shall be submitted in separate sealed envelopes labeled with the name of the project, date and time of bid opening.

The following executed documents shall be included with the submission:

- A. Proposal and Contract (MS-944)
- B. Attachment 1 to MS-944 (Proposal and Contract)
- C. Special Provisions to Contract MS-944 (Attachment 1-A)
- D. Affidavit RE Accepting Provisions of the Workman's Compensation Act
- E. Anti-Collusion Affidavit
- F. Form of Guaranty
- G. Bid Bond or Certified Check
- H. Public Works Employment Verification Form

4. Contractors Insurance

Without restricting the obligations and liability assumed by the Contractor under other sections of the specifications, the Contractor shall at his own cost and expense purchase and maintain in force until final acceptance of his work, the forms of insurance coverage described hereafter. It is the intent of the required insurance to protect the Contractor, the Owner and the Engineer from claims under Workmen's Compensation Act; and from claims for damage to property; damages because bodily injury, including death, which may arise from and during operations under this Contract, whether such operations be by himself or by any subcontractor or anyone directly or indirectly employed by either of them. The insurance requirements apply to prime contractors and subcontractors as well, unless specifically noted to the contrary.

At the time of execution of the contracts, certificates of Insurance must be furnished to the Owner and be acceptable with respect to form, coverage and company. Each certificate must provide for 10 days prior to notice, to the owner, of any cancellation or change of limits, and such notice shall be sent by registered or certified mail, with return receipt. Additional named insured shall be New Britain Township.

The minimum Limits of Insurance shall be as follows:

- a. Workmen's Compensation
 - As required by Statute
- b. General Liability
 - Bodily Injury \$1,000,000.00
 - Property Damage \$100,000.00
- c. General Umbrella Liability
 - Not less than \$2,000,000.00
- d. Automotive Liability
 - Combined Single Limit (Each Accident) \$1,000,000.00

In addition, the Contract shall maintain any other insurance necessary to protect against claims resulting from his actions, personnel, subcontractors, or equipment.

5. Payment and Performance Bonds

Payment and Performance Bonds shall be provided only by the successful bidder. Contracts under \$5,000-bonds must be in 50% of the contract amount. Contracts in excess of \$5,000-bonds must be in 100% of the amount of the contract. Bond forms MS-944 Attachments 2 & 3 and Workmen's Compensation Affidavit Attachment 4 must be submitted by the successful bidder within 15 days of the contract award. Failure to submit the bonds shall constitute grounds to cancel the contract.

6. Construction Time

The contract time for this project will be twenty (20) working days. The Contractor will be permitted to work on weekends or holidays with special permission of the owner.

7. <u>Maintenance Guarantee</u>

The Contractor shall guarantee for a term of one (1) year from the date of acceptance of the work to maintain stability of all materials and work and to promptly make good and replace all inferior or poor materials and work and to remedy all defects in materials or workmanship, all shrinkage, breakage, settlement or other faults of any kind whatsoever arising there from at his own expense. In order to secure the required guarantee, the owner shall be assured by means of a proper guaranty in the form of a bond or the deposit of funds or security in escrow in an amount equal to fifteen (15) percent of the final contract prices. Neither the acceptance of the completed work nor the making of the final payment shall release the Contractor from any of the obligations provided by this guarantee. If the Contractor fails to comply with a notice to remedy work to satisfaction the owner may cause the work to be done and collect the costs from the bonding company or escrow funds.

8. <u>Safety Requirements</u>

It shall be the single and sole responsibility of the Contractor to ensure that its activities comply with applicable safety requirements. The Owner shall not owe any duty under the Contracts or otherwise to the Contractor or its agents, employees or guests to inspect the work or otherwise ensure compliance by the Contractor with applicable safety requirements. No increases in the contract price or extensions in contract completion time shall be given by the Owner as the consequence of the Contractor's failure to so comply.

9. <u>PennDOT Liquid Fuels</u>

The bidder must be fully knowledgeable on the rules and standards of PennDOT liquid Fuels pertaining to execution of contract, subcontracting, PennDOT Roadway Specifications (Pub. 408), and other requirements relating to this project.

10. **Quantity Variations**

Where the quantity of work shown for an item in the bid schedule, including any modification thereof, is estimated, no adjustment of the contract price, or the performance time, shall be made for overruns or underruns which are within twenty-five percent (25%) of the estimated quantity of any such item.

For underruns or overruns of more than twenty-five percent (25%), the Owner shall reestimate the quantity for the item, establish an equitable contract price for the underrun or overrun of more than twenty-five (25%) percent, adjust contract performance time equitably, and modify the Contract in writing accordingly' this clause to thereafter be applicable to the total re-estimated item quantity.

RATES OF WAGES

When indicated herein the Contractor and any subcontractor shall fully comply with the applicable Wage Rate Decisions of the United States Department of Labor or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry, or the New Jersey Department of Labor and Industry.

The following (Checked) Wage Rates will apply to this job:

X PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE PENNSYLVANIA PREVAILING WAGE ACT

- a. The contractor shall pay no less than the wage rates as determined in the decision of the Secretary of Labor and Industry and shall comply with the conditions of the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act approved August 15, 1961 (Act No. 442) as amended August 9, 1963 (Act No. 342), and the Regulations issued pursuant thereto, to assure the full and proper payment of said rates.
- b. Workmen shall be paid no less than such general prevailing minimum wage rates and such other provisions to assure payment thereof as heretofore set forth in this section.
- c. The contract provisions shall apply to all work performed on the contract by the contractor and to all work performed on the contract by all subcontractors.
- d. The Contractor shall insert in each of his subcontracts all of the stipulations contained in these required provisions and such other stipulations as may be required.
- e. No workmen may be employed on the public work except in accordance with the classifications set forth in the decision of the Secretary. In the event that additional or different classifications are necessary the procedure set forth in Section 7 of these regulations shall be followed.
- f. All workmen employed or working on the public work shall be paid unconditionally, regardless of whether any contractual relationship that exists or the nature of any contractual relationship which may be alleged to exist between any Contractor, subcontractor and workmen, not less than once a week without deduction or rebate on any account, either directly or indirectly, except authorized deductions, the full amounts due at the time of payment, computed at the rates applicable to the time worked in the appropriate classification. Nothing in the contract, the Act or these regulations shall prohibit the payment of more than the general prevailing minimum wage rates as determined by the Secretary to any workman on public work.
- g. The Contractor and each subcontractor shall post for the entire period of construction the wage determination decisions of the Secretary, including the effective date of any change thereof, in a prominent and easily accessible place or places at the site of the work and at such place or places used by them to pay

workmen their wages. The posted notice of wage rates must contain the following information:

- 1. Name of Project
- 2. Name of public body of which it is being constructed.
- 3. The crafts and classifications of workmen listed in the Secretary's general prevailing minimum wage rate determination for the particular project.
- 4. The general prevailing minimum wage rate determined for each craft and classification and the effective date of any changes.
- 5. A statement advising workmen that if they have been paid less than the general prevailing minimum wage rate for their job classification or that the contractor and/or subcontractor are not complying with the Act or these Regulations in any manner whatsoever they may file a protest in writing with Secretary of Labor and Industry within three (3) months of the date of the occurrence, objecting to the payment to any contractor to the extent of the amount or amounts due to become due to them as wages for work performed on the public work project. Any workmen paid less than the rate specified in the contract shall have a civil right of action for the difference between the wage paid and the wages stipulated in the contract, which right of action must be exercised within six (6) months from the occurrence of the event creating such right.
- h. The contractor and all subcontractors shall keep an accurate record showing the name, craft and/or classification, number of hours worked per day, and the actual hourly rate of wage paid (including employee benefits) to each workman employed by him in connection with the public work and such record must include any deductions from each workman. The record shall be preserved for two years from the date of payment and shall be open at all reasonable hours to the inspection of the public body awarding the contract and to the Secretary or his duly authorized representatives.
- i. Apprentices shall be limited to such numbers as shall be in accordance with the bona fide apprenticeship program registered with and approved by the Pennsylvania Apprenticeship and Training council and only apprentices whose training and employment are in full compliance with the provisions of the Apprenticeship and Training Act approved July 14, 1961 (Act No. 304) and the Rules and Regulations issued pursuant thereto shall be employed on the public work project. Any workmen using the tools of a craft who does not qualify as an apprentice within the provisions of this subsection shall be paid the rate predetermined for journeymen in the particular craft and/or classification.
- j. Wages shall be paid without any deductions except authorized deductions. Employers not parties to a contract requiring contributions for employee benefits which the Secretary has determined to be included in the general prevailing minimum wage rate shall pay the monetary equivalent thereof directly to the workmen.
- k. Payment of compensation to workmen for performed on public work on a lump sum basis, or a piece work system, or a price certain for the completion of a certain amount of work, or the production of a certain result shall be deemed

- violation of the Act and these Regulations, regardless of the average hourly earnings resulting therefrom.
- I. Each Contractor and each subcontractor shall file a statement each week and a final statement at the conclusion of work on the contract with the contracting agency, under oath, and in form satisfactory to the Secretary, certifying that all workmen have been paid wages in strict conformity with the provisions of the contract as prescribed by this Section 3 of these Regulations, or if any wages remain unpaid to set forth the amount of wages due and owing to each workman respectively.
