BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES October 16, 2023

A Business Meeting of the New Britain Township Board of Supervisors was held on Monday, October 16, 2023, at the Township Administration Building, 207 Park Avenue, New Britain Township, PA, beginning at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisors: Chair William B. Jones, III, Vice-Chair Stephanie Shortall, Members, Gregory T. Hood, Cynthia M. Jones, and MaryBeth McCabe, Esq. Also present were Interim Township Manager John Granger, Assistant Manager Michael Walsh, Police Chief Richard Clowser, Township Engineer Craig Kennard, P.E., and Township Solicitor Sean Gresh.

- 1. Call to Order: Mr. Jones called the Meeting to order.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance: Mr. Jones led the Board and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. Chair Comments:
 - A. Executive Session:

Mr. Jones announced that the Board had met in Executive Session before the meeting to discuss personnel issues, land acquisition, and litigation.

4. Action Items:

A. Motion to consider meeting minutes of the Board of Supervisors meeting

MOTION: Upon motion by Mrs. Shortall, seconded by Ms. McCabe and unanimously carried, the Board approved the minutes of the September 25, 2023, Business Meeting and the October 2, 2023, Workshop Meeting of the New Britain Township Board of Supervisors.

B. Motion to consider schedule of bills

MOTION: Upon motion by Ms. McCabe, seconded by Mrs. Jones and unanimously carried, the Board approved the Schedule of Bills dated October 12, 2023, in the amount of \$316,110.95, and authorize the Township Manager to pay all bills, per the attachment.

C. Motion to consider consent agenda

MOTION: Upon motion by Mrs. Jones, seconded by Ms. McCabe and unanimously carried, the Board approved all items on the consent agenda, dated October 16, 2023, per the attachment.

D. Motion to consider 2024 Road Program for Bid

MOTION: Upon motion by Mr. Hood, seconded by Ms. McCabe and unanimously carried, the Board approved the 2024 Road Program and authorize advertisement in January 2024, per the attachment.

E. Motion to consider the award of the 1606 Upper State Road – Neshaminy Greenway Trail Bid

MOTION: Upon motion by Mr. Hood, seconded by Mrs. Jones and unanimously carried, the Board awarded the base bid and all the alternatives to AH Cornell and Son for the 1606 Upper State Road – Neshaminy Greenway Trail Bid, per the attachments.

F. Motion to consider authorizing the Township Solicitor to close inactive Legal & Engineering Escrow Accounts

MOTION: Upon motion by Ms. McCabe, seconded by Mr. Hood and unanimously carried, the Board approved authorizing the Township Solicitor to close inactive Legal & Engineering Escrow Accounts.

G. Motion to consider appointments to the Environmental Advisory Commission

MOTION: Upon motion by Mr. Hood, seconded by Ms. McCabe and unanimously carried, the Board appointed Margaret Briggs to the Environmental Advisory Committee for a 3-Year Term.

MOTION: Upon motion by Mrs. Jones, seconded by Ms. McCabe and unanimously carried, the Board appointed Kathleen Davis to the Environmental Advisory Committee for a 2-Year Term.

MOTION: Upon motion by Mrs. Shortall, seconded by Mr. Hood and unanimously carried, the Board appointed Kathleen Dutill to the Environmental Advisory Committee for a 2-Year Term.

MOTION: Upon motion by Ms. McCabe, seconded by Mr. Hood and unanimously carried, the Board appointed Brook Newborn to the Environmental Advisory Committee for a 1-Year Term.

Mrs. Jones read a statement stating she disagreed with the appointment of Jamie Walker and felt there were better qualified candidates. Ms. McCabe agreed.

Mrs. Shortall stated it was important for all committees to include differing points of view. Mr. Hood and Mr. Jones agreed.

Brook Newborn, Margaret Briggs, and Kathleen Davis stated this was a non-partisan committee and they hoped all appointed members would work together for the betterment of the community.

Diane Rosencrance asked the Board why her experience was being ignored.

MOTION: Upon motion by Mrs. Shortall, seconded by Mr. Hood and carried 3-2, with Mrs. Jones and Ms. McCabe opposed, the Board appointed Jamie Walker to the Environmental Advisory Committee for a 1-Year Term.

MOTION: Upon motion by Mrs. Jones, seconded by Ms. McCabe and unanimously carried, the Board appointed Kathleen Davis to the position of Chair for the Environmental Advisory Committee.

H. Motion to consider BCPC Open Space Plan Proposal

MOTION: Upon motion by Mrs. Jones, seconded by Mrs. Shortall and unanimously carried, the Board approved the Bucks County Planning Commission's Open Space Plan Proposal, per the attachments, to be paid for using Land Preservation Funds (04).
