# General Information

## Eligibility

- ▶ Turning 50 any time this year? Any individual who will be 50 years of age by 12/31/2025 may register.

## Fees

- ▶ The \$10 fee covers all sporting events
  - Participants may sign up for as many events as their schedule will allow
  - Please don't double book yourself
- ▶ Bowling and Golf have additional fees
  - The \$10 Bowling fee, payable at the event venue, includes three games and shoe rental (optional)
  - The \$51 Golf fee, payable at the event venue, includes the greens fee, cart rental, hot dog and a soda

## Registration

- ▶ Pre-registration is required
  - There are no walk-on Registrations
