BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MEETING MINUTES November 6, 2023

A Business Meeting of the New Britain Township Board of Supervisors was held on Monday, November 6, 2023, at the Township Administration Building, 207 Park Avenue, New Britain Township, PA, beginning at 7:00 p.m. Present were Supervisors: Chair William B.
