  - Alert Neshaminy Watershed Association (NWA) would like to do a planting along Greenway Trail; vote on recommendation in July to BOS to support. Grant obtained by NWA.

- Parking and "Green Parking Lots" recommendations
  - Curb cuts or no curbs for green islands, so trees do well and the stormwater runoffs; saves money by not having curbs when developed.
  - Layered approach, with shrubs and trees
  - New development and redevelopment (50% or more change, land development ordinances. Recommend that township require green parking to help meet MS4 stormwater remediation (replace stormwater basins or reduce).
  - Also, cut down the required parking in our ordinance. Need to ensure green parking is implemented.
  - Incentive to developers to get quicker approval. (time = money)
  - At base of Wegman's (MontCo); by 309 side big swatch of no curb, big rain garden
- Change of EAC meeting schedule
  - Change to first Wednesday, beginning in September (Sept. 4, Oct. 2, Nov. 6, Dec 4).
    Cancel August meeting.
  - Motion to change meeting made by C. Weston-Young; seconded by K. Dutill. Passed unanimously.

- Public comment on non-agenda items
  - M. McCabe voiced appreciation for the tick notice.
  - Resident L. Jones suggested the EAC support "Lights Out" during bird migration periods and she volunteered to send further information to the EAC. M. Briggs to draft memo suggesting that BOS officially support a resolution, which will be discussed at the next EAC meeting.
  - Bird Town application consider during a future meeting (\$100 application).
